Subsequent to the close of public comment, a revised draft Consistency Determination and a revised draft Recommendation Report may be prepared. It is anticipated that the draft Consistency Determination and Recommendation Report for the above Highlands Redevelopment Area Designation application may be reviewed by the Highlands Council at its scheduled meeting on **Thursday, February 16, 2017**. The Highlands Council will consider the Highlands Redevelopment Area Designation by way of a formal resolution; an opportunity for public comment will be provided at that time as well. However, it should be noted that the opportunity for public comment at the Council meeting may be limited and that the Council may vote on the resolution the same day. Therefore, the applicant and the public are strongly encouraged to provide all comments and information during the initial comment period on the draft Consistency Determination and draft Staff Report.
